

“Book in a Box” Project

Use a shoe box to complete this creative book report. Be sure to include the lid in order to keep all items contained within the box.

Step 1:

Decorate your box to reflect the book that you have read. Decorations can reflect scenes from the book, characters, or the overall theme of the book. Be creative!

Step 2:

Inside the box you are required to have the following items:

- Your completed Book Report Outline Template
- Your completed Book Report (may be shared on Google Docs if you prefer)
- A glossary with at least 10 unfamiliar words and their definitions. The glossary is to include the sentence, chapter and page number where the unfamiliar word can be found.
- Three artifacts or items that relate or can be connected to the story. These items will be discussed in your presentation to the class and will be returned to you upon the completion of your presentation.

Step 3:

Presentation: You will present your box, glossary, and artifacts to the class on the due date (May 11th). Be sure to come prepared, having rehearsed your presentation.

Students who place extra effort in their presentations will receive up to five points of extra credit. Additional creative elements may include

- Dressing up as one of the characters in the book
- Connecting elements from the reading to ideas learned in world history or language arts
- Surprise me!
